Austin, Pflugerville, and Dallas-Fort Worth areas

Your ideal or desired resident:

An addict who has completed a recognized treatment program and can pay for rent and food.

Size of house/layout:

6 people to a residence –two to each room

Fee structure:

\$125.00 per week plus food arrangements

Philosophy:

Addicts must “learn” to stay clean and sober. We work with our residents to engage in valuable learning environments that promote positive social rehabilitation.

Structure:

Each home has a resident counselor who works closely with residents. Our director is a trained program coordinator and curriculum designer for transitional facilities who has researched the challenges of developing transitional living environments.

Our director of residential services is a respected member of community organizations involved in community action for recovery from addiction. She has spoken all over the country on the subject of staying clean and sober and works very closely with all residents in the Austin-Pflugerville area.

Programs/Activities:

Various cultural, educational, and learning activities, as well as recovery programs, are promoted as social rehabilitation resources. Family activities are encouraged and arranged at the residence. Weekly meetings and group sessions are planned in advance.
