**Philosophy:**

To provide a sober living environment that promotes the mental and spiritual health of its members. This includes supporting a system of integrity, guidance, and honesty. A safe place to learn how to live life in recovery.

**Structure:**

House managers live on property to monitor the household and uphold sober living rules. Residents are accountable to managers for daily activities such as employment, meetings, etc.

**Programs/Activities:**

We have random drug/alcohol screening. We have zero tolerance policy for using or breaking a house rule. Failure to submit to UA results in eviction from property.

Weekly House meetings, recovery/aftercare plans, and house programs are reviewed weekly.

Sobriety coach on property. He will give rides to the early morning AA meeting at Western Trails every day.

Monday night AA meeting on property made available to those who voluntarily want to attend.

12 step meeting schedule: Residents are required to attend at least three meetings a week, have a sponsor and working the steps.
